New Year Flu Vaccine Amnesty

If your horse's vaccination cover for equine influenza is not up to date, why not make it your new year's resolution to get them fully protected and ready for the opportunities of 2022? Even if you don't like to compete you could enter a pleasure ride or attend a clinic for like-minded riders all safe in the knowledge that your horse will have protection against catching equine influenza (Flu).

For horses who have their first dose of Flu or combined Flu and Tetanus vaccine in January the second dose of vaccine will be given free of charge.

Normal visit charges will apply—remember to save on visit charges you can make use of our monthly zone days. The recommended interval between first and second vaccine is 4– 6 weeks.

Always remember to check the competition rules regarding vaccine intervals before you compete as there is significant variation between the competitive disciplines.

Next Dental Clinic Thursday January 27th

The dental clinic allows us to work more efficiently and so we are able to pass on that saving to you with reduced price routine dentistry (a saving of £27.50 on the usual price of a routine dental).

Dental clinics are for routine dental procedures, including examination, power rasping enamel overgrowths, and diastema cleaning and flushing all carried out under sedation.

Top tips to stay healthy this winter

- Try to ensure your horse has some exercise every day: turn out, hand-walking or ridden. This is important to assist gut movement, help reduce joint pain in older horses and help with weight management.
- Avoid over rugging your horse: the warm moist environment under a rug can increase the risk of skin disease.
- Make sure your horse's teeth have been examined and any issues addressed, to help maintain optimum weight and reduce the risk of choke.
- Body condition score your horse regularly; remember you should be able to easily feel ribs and crest should be soft. Those prone to putting on weight should aim to finish the winter in lean condition.

Annual membership fee or renewal must be paid in full prior to the visit.
